It is understood and agreed that the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", adopted April 1, 2016, and the "Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions", adopted January 1, 2017, prepared by the Department of Transportation, shall govern insofar as they may be applied and insofar as they do not conflict with the special provisions and supplemental specifications attached hereto.
2. It is understood that quantities listed are approximate only and that they may be increased or decreased as may be needed to properly complete the improvement within its present limits or extensions thereto, at the unit price stated and that bids will be compared on the basis of the total price bid for each group.
3. Delivery in total or partial shipments as ordered shall be made within the time specified in the special provisions or by the acceptance at the point and in the manner specified in the "Schedule of Prices". If delivery on the job site is specified, it shall mean any place or places on the road designated by the awarding authority or its authorized representative.

FURNISH PIPE CULVERTS

INSPECTION

All material shall be State of Illinois Inspected at the plant of fabrication. A visual inspection shall also be performed by the Awarding Agency at the delivery point to see that the material has maintained good condition during delivery.

DETERMINATION OF LOW BID

Awards will be made per group to the lowest responsible bid.

DELIVERY

Delivery of pipe culverts shall be made prior to delivery dates or the bid check shall be forfeited to the said Road District. Each Group must receive 24 hours notice prior to their delivery. All pipe culverts shall be marked to indicate the Group Number and pipe size. All pipe culverts shall be delivered on or before May 1, 2017.

PIPES

All pipe culverts shall be Annular Galvanized Corrugated Steel Pipe as per Section 542 in the Standard Specifications adopted April 1, 2016, as modified by Special Provision LR542-1(attached).

All pipe culverts shall be Type 1 for Fill Heights 3 feet or less as per Section 542 in the Standard Specifications adopted April 1, 2016, unless otherwise specified, in the pipe list included at the end of this proposal.

Elongation specified by Article 542.04(e) will be performed during installation utilizing Method 3. Pipe shall be round at time of delivery.

Note: The 42" pipe in Group 48 shall be furnished with lifting loops. The 60" pipe in Group 52 shall be furnished with lifting loops.

Effective: April 1, 2016

All references to Sections or Articles in this specification shall be construed to mean a specific Section or Article of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, adopted by the Department of Transportation.

Description. This work shall be performed in accordance with Section 542 of the Standard Specifications, except that Aluminized Type 2 Steel or Precoated Galvanized Steel is not required for pipe diameters up to 42 inches.

Basis of Payment. The basis of payment shall be in accordance with Article 542.11 of the Standard Specifications. The material will be paid for at the contract unit price bid per meter (foot) of PIPE CULVERTS, SPECIAL of the diameters or equivalent round size specified, and of the particular kind of material when specified.
